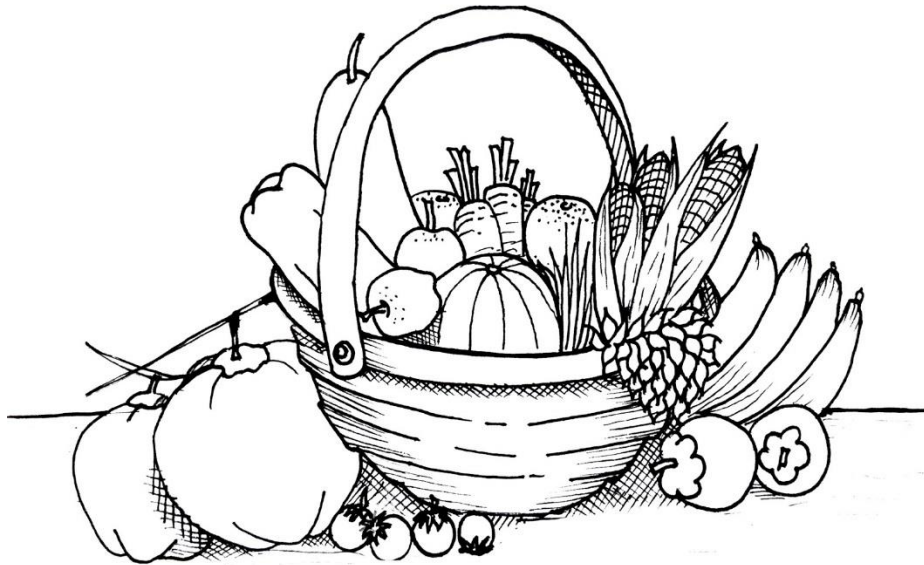

Prize list of rules and regulations.

- Entries to the Fair are to be made between 10 am and 12:30 pm.
- Only one entry per class for each exhibitor is permitted.
- Entry fees for juniors and adults is \$1.00 per entry
- Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st prize - \$5.00
 - 2nd prize - \$2.00
 - 3rd prize - \$1.00
- Judges may withhold or lower placings if, in their opinion, entries are not worthy, for whatever reason of 1st, 2nd or 3rd place prize.
- All entries must be clean and stain free, and **NOT PREVIOUSLY ENTERED IN THE CHERRY GROVE FAIR.**
- Exhibitors are requested to remove their display items between 4:30pm and 5:30 pm the day of the show.
- Judging will start at 1:00 pm on the day of the Fair.
